The Local Government Act 1999 requires council elections to be conducted by full postal ballot every 4 years in November. 67 South Australian local Councils are presenting candidates for you to vote in Mayor, area representative and/or ward representative.

If you are correctly enrolled for state elections in South Australia, you are automatically included on the council voters' roll and will have received ballot papers through the post. https://ecsa.sa.gov.au/voting/voting-in-councilelections#Reissue_BP_LG

If you own or occupy property in the council or are the designated person of a body corporate or group which occupies or owns property in the council area, you may have been eligible to vote but this list has closed.




