## **Milang Flood Risk**

The flood risk in Milang has increased, and while it won't be like the devastation we've seen in the Riverland and along the Murray River, it is in my electorate and, for that reason, has been front and centre of my mind.

The risk in Milang is to a row of shacks and the infrastructure around this area. Lake Alexandrina is affected by the increase in water flowing into the lower lakes, the tide and wind pushing the water to create waves.

# Goolwa Beach Pipi Closure

Effective immediately from 12 January 2023, Goolwa Beach has closed to recreational fishing of bivalve molluscs, including Pipi (Goolwa Cockle), until further notice following the detection of E.coli in Pipis above what is safe for human consumption.

The public cannot collect any Pipi or other bivalves molluscs from this area until further notice.

The fishing of Pipis closure includes the entire Goolwa Beach from the Murray Mouth to Middleton Point near Mill Terrace at Middleton.

PIRSA will undertake further testing, and the closure will remain in place until two "below threshold" results show the Pipis are safe for human consumption.

There have been closures of the fishing of Pipis in the past, most recently, two short closures during the summer of 2016/17.



Other activities in the river and the beach remain unchanged. You may consider participating in water activities at beaches away from Goolwa Beach. Testing will continue by the various government departments, and we will continue to update the community if anything changes.
